Projected program milestones:

Cessna unveiled its newest business jet on Monday, introducing the Citation M2 to our global salesforce, prospective customers and top industry journalists. A cabin mock-up of the aircraft will make its public debut in two weeks at the NBAA Annual Meeting and Convention in Las Vegas.

The Citation M2 is a new light business jet positioned between the Citation Mustang and the Citation CJ family.

“Operator feedback and owner insight have indicated a market for a Citation with the size, speed and range of the Citation M2. We expect to see customers new to the Citation family, Mustang owners looking for a logical next step or CJ1+ operators who want a new, more advanced Citation,” said **Scott Ernest**, president and CEO.

The Citation M2 features Cessna’s Intrinsic flight deck powered by Garmin G3000 avionics, engines similar to those found in the CJ series and

an all-new cabin design. Priced at \$4.195 million, the aircraft seats six passengers and two pilots.

Powered by a pair of FADEC-controlled Williams International FJ44-1AP-21 turboprop engines, the Citation M2 has a maximum cruise speed of 400 knots true airspeed and a range of 1,300 nautical miles. The aircraft offers great short field performance and will climb to 41,000 feet in 25 minutes. See more aircraft specifications on page 2.

In the cockpit, the Garmin G3000 avionics suite seamlessly integrates numerous Garmin-designed system components into an easy-to-use flightdeck to simplify operation and enhance situational awareness during flight and when taxiing. One of the most popular features of the system is a pair of touch-screen controllers that allow multi-function display page navigation as well as audio and FMS control. The Garmin GTC 570 controllers (the same found

in the Corvalis TTX) react to changes in an infrared grid rather than traditional surface resistance sensors for better response under a variety of conditions.

Eight large windows, roomy pedestal seats and intuitive cabin appointments highlight the all-new interior.

“Thanks to everyone whose hard work got the program this far,” Scott said. “The introduction of this new airplane is a great example of our continued investment in new products which is one of our four company priorities. It also is a vote of confidence in the men and women of Cessna who will produce it. With your winning attitude and a continued focus on our customer, we have a very bright future.”

CITATION M2: MODEL 525



The Citation M2 is Cessna's new \$4.195 million light jet that fills the gap between the Citation Mustang and Citation CJ family. First flight and certification testing will begin in 2012; FAA certification (Part 23) is planned for the first half of 2013, followed by the start of deliveries soon after.

- From the cockpit divider aft through the rear lavatory: 11 feet long with a 5-inch dropped aisle providing a cabin height of 57 inches

- Configurable for 2 crew and 6 passengers
- Purpose-built storage for mobile devices at each seat

Skycatcher and McCauley news

At AOPA, we announced that McCauley's 1L100 fixed-pitch composite propeller is now standard on the Skycatcher. This all-composite two-blade, fixed-pitch propeller was made specifically for the Skycatcher's Continental Motors O-200D engine and is ASTM approved. It became standard equipment beginning with serial number 108, and it will be offered to existing Model 162 owners for retrofit.
